BrüRm @ BAR 'Aberdeen Ale' 5.3% *Style: Scottish 80/- Export Ale* From New Haven, CT
Smooth and easy-drinking ale brewed with a proportion of peat smoked malt. A new brew from brewmaster Jeff Browning at his Connecticut brewpub.
\$4.50 - 10oz / \$7.00 - 16oz / \$8.75 - 20oz

BrüRm @ BAR 'Chocolate Porter' 8.0% *Style: Robust Porter* From New Haven, CT
Brewed with 4lbs of dark cocoa, this bold, dark brew is full of chocolatey goodness in the aroma and on the palate.

Dogfish Head '75 Minute IPA' 7.5% *Style: American I.P.A.* From Milton, DE
"Johnny Cask", as the brewery nicknames it, is a cask-only blend of 60- and 90-Minute IPAs primed with maple syrup. Dangerously drinkable.

Erie 'Railbender Ale' 6.8% *Style: Scottish 90/- "Wee Heavy"* From Erie, PA
Deep amber with a malt backbone featuring a caramel sweetness; mild hops. Named for the railroad workers who originally laid the country's tracks.

Honest Town 'Capall Dorche Stout' 4.2% *Style: Dry Irish Stout* From Southbridge, MA
Black and intriguing as midnight, Capall Dorche is a velvety smooth and full bodied session stout with a rich, creamy mouthfeel. Mild, roasted flavors give way to a cocoa and milk chocolate finish. Balanced and drinkable, Balanced with judicious additions of Nugget and East Kent Goldings hops. 30 IBUs. The name is from the Old Irish meaning 'Dark Horse'.

Honest Town 'IPA' 6.3% *Style: American I.P.A.* From Southbridge, MA
Robust, deep copper ale with rich toasted and woody malt flavors and a distinct spicy hop bitterness (72 IBUs) and citrusy aroma. Brewmaster Mike Labbe infuses it with whole Centennial hops using this small, obscure brewery's hopback system, which enhances the aroma. Hopped with Nugget, East Kent Goldings, Cascade, and Centennial varieties.

Olde Burnside 'Ten Penny Ale' 5.5% *Style: Scottish 80/- Export Ale* From East Hartford, CT **- MAIN BAR -**
Dark amber, malty, peaty ale with toffee and butterscotch on the palate. This little-seen (here) family-run brewery is a spin off from an ice-making company.

Ridgeway 'Reindeer Droppings' 4.7% *Style: English Pale Ale* From Horsham, West Sussex, England **- MAIN BAR -**
An deep amber colored English ale brewed for the festive season, hoppy with some sweet malt flavor. This is the only cask of this beer in New York.

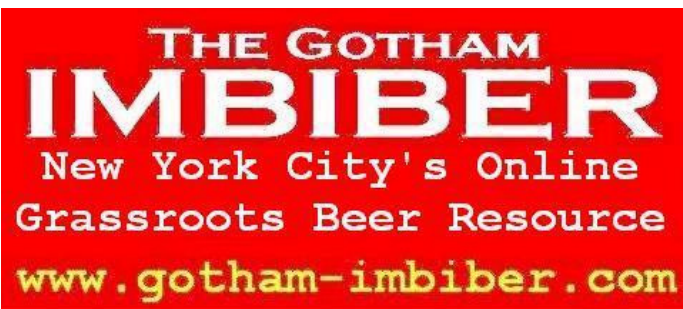
Sauer Rossdorf 'Rossdorfer Urbräu' 4.6% *Style: Kellerbier* From Rossdorf-am-Forst, Germany **- MAIN BAR -**
A crisp, grassy, herbal unfiltered lager from a small brewing operation situated in the forest surrounding Bamberg.
\$4.50 - 10oz / \$7.00 - 16oz / \$8.75 - 20oz

Shawnee 'Vienna Lager' 4.8% *Style: Vienna Lager (Organic)* From Shawnee-on-Delaware, PA
Brewed with 100% organic ingredients by brewmaster Leo Bongiorno at this little-known brewpub which was founded last year, this is a rare session lager, golden and quenching.
\$4.00 - 10oz / \$6.00 - 16oz / \$7.50 - 20oz

Shawnee 'Bourbon Barrel-Aged Entire' 6.5% *Style: "London Porter", barrel-aged* From Shawnee-on-Delaware, PA
Dark, rich 'London Porter', enticing and smooth. This rare version (the only cask in New York) has been aged in a bourbon barrel, imparting notes of oak and bourbon. A beer to be sipped and savored.

Stone 'Sublimely Self Righteous Ale' 8.7% *Style: American Strong Ale* From Escondido, CA
First brewed in 2007 as Stone 11th Anniversary Ale, this is a dark ale brewed with plenty of piney hops and plenty of conceit. A sort of 'Dark IPA', dry-hopped in the cask with Chinook and Columbus
\$5.00 - 10oz / \$8.00 - 16oz / \$10.00 - 20oz
