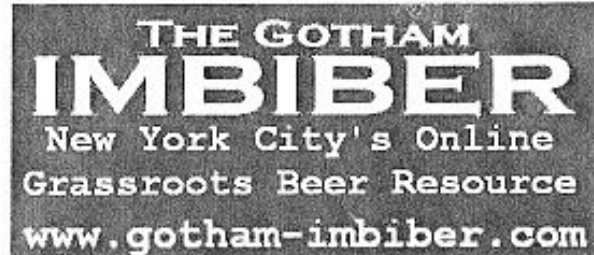


1st LITITZ CASK BEER FESTIVAL

The General Sutter Inn, 12 – 14 March 2010



Join the craft beer revolution.
You'll enjoy it.

A beer token system is in use for the festival beers. Please buy tokens before ordering from the festival bar. A full sheet of tokens is \$20, but you can purchase any denomination. Each token is worth 50c.

- Blue Point 'Sour Cherry Imperial Stout' (9.0%) *Style: Russian Imperial Stout From Patchogue, New York* 10oz: 9 16oz: 15 20oz: 18
Black and bold with notes of dark fruit, caramel, roasted malt, and with a slight underlying fruit tartness.
- Boston Beer Works Canal St. 'Uber Doppelsticke' (10.0%) *Style: Altbier, wood aged From Boston, Massachusetts* 10oz: 9 16oz: 15 20oz: 18
Deep brown with a malty, sweet, oaky aroma. Full bodied with a chewy malt character and complex flavors of raisin, vanilla, dark fruit, caramel, and toasty oak. Oak aged in a Sam Adams Utopias barrel for over three months.
- Boulder 'Obovoid' (6.8%) *Style: Oatmeal Stout From Boulder, Colorado* 10oz: 7 16oz: 11 20oz: 14
Dark and silky oak-barrel-aged Oatmeal Stout, earthy, rich, and very rare in cask-conditioned form.
- Brooklyn 'Cookie Jar Porter' (7.8%) *Style: Robust Porter From Brooklyn, New York* 10oz: 8 16oz: 13 20oz: 16
Inspired by the delicious cookies made at Feed Your Soul Bakery in New Jersey, this dark and delicious ale is brewed with golden oats, raisins, brown sugar, honey, vanilla beans and a subtle dash of spice. All these flavors meld together with light chocolate, coffee and caramel notes.
- BrüRm@BAR 'Damn Good Stout' (5.2%) *Style: American Stout From New Haven, Connecticut* 10oz: 6 16oz: 10 20oz: 12
Seven different malts meld in this black, roasty brew with notes of roasted barley and cocoa.
- BrüRm@BAR 'AmBAR Ale' (5.8%) *Style: American Amber Ale From New Haven, Connecticut* 10oz: 6 16oz: 10 20oz: 12
The aroma is of fruit and caramel, while on the palate this brew is predominantly malty and nutty with a rich caramel sweetness and notes of raisins. It has a light finish that leaves your palate clean and ready for more.
- Chelsea 'Hoppy Holiday' (10.2%) *Style: American Strong Ale From New York, New York* 10oz: 8 16oz: 13 20oz: 16
Full bodied strong festive ale, aged for several months, big on both malt and hops. Well-balanced and powerful.

- Cigar City Humidor Series: 'Jai Alai Cedar Aged IPA' (7.5%) *Style: American IPA* *From Tampa, Florida* 10oz: 7 16oz: 11 20oz: 14
Aged on cedar, a little subtler than oak, is this delightful and rare orange-gold ale with notes of pine, citrus, and caramel. Not fined, will be cloudy.
- East End 'Snow Melt Winter Ale' (7.1%) *Style: American Strong Ale* *From Pittsburgh, Penn.* 10oz: 7 16oz: 11 20oz: 14
A rich malty, dark ruby-red, lightly spiced winter ale which is a rare find in this area. "Guaranteed to clear the fog off your glasses."
- Golden Avalanche Tavern Ale Series: 'American I.P.A.' (7.0%) *Style: American IPA* *From Kutztown, Penn.* 10oz: 6 16oz: 10 20oz: 12
Deep amber ale with quite a big hop bite. This is apparently the first time this brewery's beer has been served in cask-conditioned form!
- Heartland 'Belgian Chocolate L'Orange' (8.5%) *Style: Belgian Strong Dark* *From Brooklyn, New York* 10oz: 7 16oz: 11 20oz: 14
Reddish-brown ale brewed with chocolate nibs and sweet orange peel. Spicy, with a bold chocolate aroma and silky finish.
- Kuhnenn 'DRIPA' (8.0%) *Style: Double / Imperial IPA* *From Warren, Michigan* 10oz: 8 16oz: 13 20oz: 16
An interesting deviation from the norm (of craft brewing) – a double IPA very unusually brewed with a proportion of rice, and (much more typically lots of hops! Dry and crisp with an intense hoppiness. This is no Budweiser...
- Lancaster 'Shoo-Fly Porter' (7.5%) *Style: Robust Porter* *From Lancaster, Penn.* 10oz: 6 16oz: 10 20oz: 12
Dark brown ale brewed with molasses, medium-to-full bodied with notes of chocolate and roasted malt. Locally brewed.
- Oliver's 'Bishop's Breakfast Stout' (4.4%) *Style: Oatmeal Stout* *From Baltimore, Maryland* 10oz: 6 16oz: 10 20oz: 12
Black, roasty Oatmeal Stout, a very easy drinking, smooth beer great for a session.
- Oliver's 'Best Bitter' (4.8%) *Style: English Best Bitter* *From Baltimore, Maryland* 10oz: 6 16oz: 10 20oz: 12
Medium-bodied English Bitter with a well balanced hop profile (Bramling Cross, Fuggles, and East Kent Goldings varieties).
- Pearl Street 'Sabers Edge Imperial IPA' (8.0%) *Style: Double / Imperial IPA* *From Buffalo, New York* 10oz: 8 16oz: 13 20oz: 16
A rare copper-hued Double IPA from this Buffalo brewpub, piney with a strong finish.
- Pretty Things 'St. Botolph's Town' (5.7%) *Style: English Brown Ale* *From Westport, Mass.* 10oz: 6 16oz: 10 20oz: 12
Interesting "Rustic Dark Ale" brewed with malt from Yorkshire, and fermented with Belgian and German yeast strains.
- Shawnee 'Session Porter' (5.3%) *Style: Robust Porter* *From Shawnee-on-Deel, Penn.* 10oz: 6 16oz: 10 20oz: 12
This is a delicious rich ruby red ale brewed at this fairly new, innovative brewery near the Delaware Water Gap. Good things come out of there...
- Sixpoint 'Righteous Ale' (7.2%) *Style: Rye Beer* *From Brooklyn, New York* 10oz: 7 16oz: 11 20oz: 14
From this hugely popular New York City craft brewery comes this bold reddish-hued ale with a big rye spiciness on the palate.
- Troegs 'Nugget Nectar' (7.5%) *Style: American Amber Ale* *From Harrisburg, Penn.* 10oz: 6 16oz: 10 20oz: 12
Ever popular, this golden amber ale is perfectly balanced with Nugget hops and malt partnering for a delicious cask experience.
- Willimantic 'Poor Richard's Olde Ale' (6.9%) *Style: Old Ale/Winter Warmer* *From Willimantic, Connecticut* 10oz: 7 16oz: 11 20oz: 14
Based on a colonial recipe, this dark brown ale is brewed with molasses for that rich toffee flavor.
