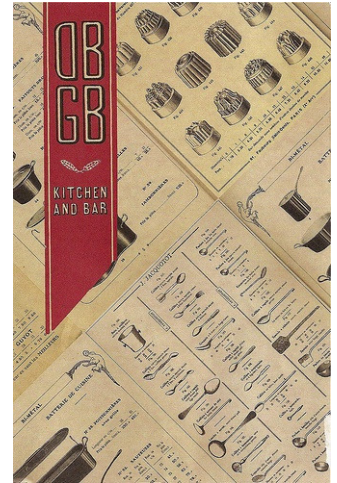

New for summer 2009 is this upmarket French brasserie under the wing of celebrity chef Daniel Boulud. The 24 taps all dispense craft beer, including several imports from Belgium and neighboring countries, and there is an interesting, upscale bottle list (which includes some exotic and very expensive European imports – check the prices before ordering if you're on a budget). The front bar area is modern and stylish, with surrounding mirrors and much glass, giving a bright, open feel. The mirrors are adorned with quotations. Seating at the bar is unusually on padded benches. There is a long dining lounge area at the rear, which you have to traverse when visiting the bathrooms – located behind the open kitchen. Opening hours are noon to midnight daily. While there is also a strong emphasis on good wine here, it is a very welcome happening when a celebrity chef devotes attention to quality beers to pair with his gourmet food.
