Two cask handpumps and a vast selection of draught and bottled beers feature here. D deservedly popular and walkable from both Grand Central and Penn rail stations; The Ginger Man is close to The Empire State Building, which can be seen through the front windows. Beware of busy times (just after office hours), it often fills to capacity. A third cask ale, on gravity, is tapped every Wednesday. Now doing growler fills. Opening hours: Mon-Wed 11.30am-2am, Thurs-Fri 11.30am-4am, Sat 12.30pm-4am, Sun 3pm-4am. There's a pleasant lounge area at the back. Part of a small Texas based chain of dedicated beer bars. Food is mainly soups and sandwiches.
