Recycling at its best. The former Lenora's Way / Wells Ales and Lagers space has been transformed into a wonderful patchwork of reclaimed wood, New York breweriana, and great beer on tap and cask. All but one or two of the 20 tap lines are ever changing craft beers, mostly domestic but with a few imports, and there is a cask-conditioned beer pumped up from the cellar where an annex to the walk-in box keeps it at the perfect temperature. The interior, including the bar, is built out of wood reclaimed from Brooklyn tenement buildings, and 1950s-era beer neon signs and tap handles abound – which is in tune with the old school CD jukebox. There's a shuffleboard table (from 1975), and a fair sized back yard for good weather. Food is limited to meat and cheese plates. Basically, this is a no frills beer bar with a big nod to New York's brewing heritage. Open 2pm to 4am in the week, noon to 4am Saturdays, noon to 2am Sundays.
