

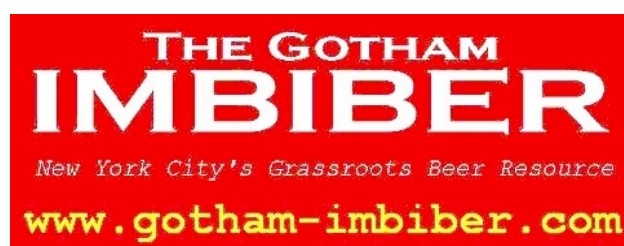
CASK-CONDITIONED 'OLA DUBH' VERTICAL TASTING

Ola Dubh, meaning 'Black Oil', is an exciting collaboration between Harviestoun Brewery of Alva, Scotland, and Highland Park Distillery. It is based on the award-winning 'Old Engine Oil', brewed by Harviestoun. Stylistically similar to the Imperial Porters and Stouts of the nineteenth century, this deliciously rich beer is the first ale to be aged in malt whisky casks from a named distillery.

There are four variants of one base beer on offer here for you to compare in this amazing vertical tasting opportunity. The beers on each of our four handpumps have been aged in wooden malt whisky casks formerly used to mature Highland Park 12 Year Old, 18 Year Old, 30 Year Old, and 40 Year Old respectively.

The dense, black, oily appearance of this beer (similar to used motor oil) was the decisive factor in choosing a name. In all versions, there are aromas of truffle oil and cocoa, plus a little smokiness and heathery peat. On the palate, it is complexly oily, pithy, with a smooth bitterness and a little saltiness. The long finish yields some burnt notes with some hop character, smokiness, oakiness, and a little citrus fruit. The 12 Year Old has some toasted malts and a hint of sweet raspberry, while the 30 Year Old has rich vinous, pine resin, honey, and juniper notes in its elegant portfolio of flavours. The 18 and 40 Year Old versions are very new releases and have not been previously sampled. All 'Ola Dubh' versions are 8.0% alcohol by volume.

Listed alcohol by volume: 12 Year Old and 18 Year Old are 11.0%, 30 Year Old is 8.0%, 40 Year Old is 10.5%.
