18 taps and a cask pump serve a wide range of mostly domestic and imported craft beers, always very impressive. There is a sister pub, opened at a later date, in Manhattan. On the route of bus B61 to Williamsburg and B63 to Park Slope. No cask ale in summer. Open from 11.30am daily. Background jazz music is usually playing. Also known as "Pete's Ale House", despite the owner's name being Sam.

Subway: Borough Hall – Court Street **R 2 3 4** (+ **M 5** rush hours) or Bergen Street **F G**



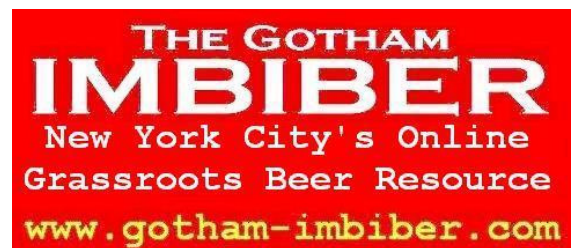
